Please understand that creating a rehearsal schedule on this scale to meet your availability is very time consuming. There may be mistakes in who is called, check what scenes you are in as well as looking for your name and if in doubt please ask Deborah. We are looking for another rehearsal space so we can call further music doubling up rehearsals so expect some additions to this schedule. We will always try and give you two weeks warning of calls.

Rehearsals are going well and people seem to be enjoying them. We have, as we would expect, a small number of people drop out. This is generally because they either suddenly realise it's a commitment they can't keep or a change in their circumstances. Obviously the later anyone drops out the harder it is to crawl back any rehearsals and recasting. I will be asking people to take on extra lines and parts at rehearsals. Some people have visited rehearsals they are not in – and ended up in the scenes.
